MLA in-text citations are brief references in the body of your document which direct your reader to the full reference in the list of Works Cited. You must include an in-text citation whenever you quote, paraphrase, or refer to information from a source. A standard MLA in-text citation includes the author's last name and a page number in parentheses. The page number refers to the exact location of the quote or information that you are citing:
